Critique

PUPPY DOG (2)

1 Davies' Zymore Irish Cream. 9 month dog who was much more together than the second. Head broad and in proportion but still needing to break, good pigment, dark round eye. Good reach of neck leading into well placed shoulders. Well boned with neat feet, well feathered. Held his topline at all time and really used himself on the move. **BEST PUPPY**

2 Gill's Diptonia The Celt. Almost 12 months old and smaller than 1, appealed for his lovely head, dark round eye, defined stop and well set and carried ears. Excellent bone and feet and good angles both fore and aft but I felt he lacked a little in body length. Moved positively and shown in lovely condition.

JUNIOR DOG (1)

1 Davies' Zymore Irish Cream.

POST GRADUATE DOG (1)

1 Whitaker's Viewland Uncle Walter. 2 year old dog and quite mature for his age, built along classic lines. Head a little broader than ideal which gave him the impression of a short muzzle. Well boned legs, just needs to firm in front movement, well bodied, good topline and tailset, hocks well let down and shown in good coat and condition.

LIMIT DOG (1)

1 Ryan & McDonald's Berryessa Royal Affinity of Ryemills JW. Smart clean lined dog of pleasing type, but would prefer a little more length for ideal balance. Broad masculine head, strong neck leading to well constructed shoulders, deep chest and well angulated rear. Really enjoying his day out here which when assessing movement made it difficult. A very good clour and presented in good condition.

OPEN DOG (3)

1st: Valentine's Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Tullamore Ted JW ShCM. Well headed dog of good type and balance, masculine without coarseness, well set ears, defined stop, strong pigment, correct dark round eye. Super reach of neck leading into well placed shoulders, well boned and with neat well feathered feet, deep chest leading to correct length of loin. Super well angulated hindquarters, moved with drive holding his top line as he went with correct tail carriage. Very well marked and presented immaculately, pleased he was short listed in a good group. **BEST DOG & BOB**

2 Wade's Sh Ch Casafelice Arles Merino. Smart masculine dog, as with 1 very well headed, good neck, plenty of fore chest, well boned legs with good feet. Deep chested, well bodied, strong topline and through the loin leading to a correctly set tail, well defined hocks and moving on a good stride. Another who well presented. **RESERVE BEST DOG**

3 Ward's Caispern Nicolaus Silver Cum Copperwhite JW ShCM.

LIMIT BITCH (3,1)

1 Housby's Tullamore Tiggywinkle. Lovely type of bitch feminine head, very good markings, good bone, super shoulders and excelling in front angulation. A little hesitant when first going over her but she settled after moving. Deep chest, excellent topline and well angulated hindquarters, moving very well with correct tail carriage. Considered for higher honours.

2 Ward's Copperwhite Cinnamon. Lovely coloured bitch, really appealed for her lovely head and shape. So typical in outline, stands on good legs and feet. In good body and lovely condition. Lost out on her erratic movement.

OPEN BITCH (3)

1 Barcroft's Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Ballakinnish Mistinguette CW08 CW09. Impressive bitch built on clean lines with super markings, feminine head, dark round eye, defined stop and well set ears, correct length of neck and well placed shoulders, correct bone and feet. Deep through chest leading to correct length of loin, strong topline well held and with well developed hindquarters. Presented in immaculate coat and moved with ease on a long stride. Pushed the dog all the way for BOB. **BEST BITCH**

2 Webb's Sh Ch Shannonlee The Skylark JW. Another worthy champion who excels in type and balance, correct head with a well defined stop and typical expression. Stands on well boned legs, very good front assembly, deep chested and moved well on a positive stride. **RESERVE BEST BITCH**

3 Ward's Copperwhite Cordelia.

1 Housby's Tullamore Tiggywinkle.
