Critique

Junior Dog (1)

1st Collins Corranroo Cloudchaser At Forestpoint – Just 14 months and still very much a teenager, lovely in outline with reasonable angles front and rear, good head and expression though I would prefer a darker eye, coat of lovely colour and in good condition. He was very unsettled in the ring and his movement was very difficult to assess, would like to see him in an outside ring.

Post Grad Dog (3)

1st Wades Ballakinnish Malachi At Oldestone – I have admired this young man from the ringside on many occasions and it was a pleasure to get my hands on him. Smart boy in profile, lovely head with soft gentle expression, good length to neck and clean over the shoulders, well sprung ribs and firm over the loin, balanced angles front and rear, when settled he moved on an easy stride driving well from the rear, needs his coat to complete the picture, he is only a youngster but maturing along nicely – one for the future.

2nd Walpoles Lovenejoel Ice Cool – Nice type, masculine head with pleasing expression, could be cleaner over the shoulders, lovely spring to ribs, firm loin, good bend to stifles, coat in good condition and of good colour, sound mover but feel his owner could get so much more from this nice boy.

3rd Pilmers Rustasha Red Hot Royal At Anisbrig

Limit Dog (2)

1st Lambs Casafelice Montadale JW – Super boy, lovely head of correct proportions, nice dark eye, soft gentle expression, good length to neck, clean over shoulders, well sprung ribs, firm loin, strong rear quarters, lovely angulations to the front and rear, short rear pasterns which he used to advantage on the move, lovely profile movement and sound coming and going away, coat of correct colour and in lovely condition, could just do with a touch more length to coat, but this will come as he matures, after all it is only the icing on the cake. In my opinion he was the best male here on the day for breed type and sound movement and it was my pleasure to award him the **CC his 2nd**, however, I do feel he needs another 12 months on him to fully complete the overall picture.

2nd Davies Zymore Irish Cream – A favourite of mine who just did not like the overhead fans and this greatly affected is normal sound driving movement. Lovely headed boy with a nice dark expressive eyes, good length of neck through to clean shoulders, well sprung ribs, firm loin, strong quarters, in lovely coat and condition.

Open Dog (4) 1 absentee

1st Waltons Sh.Ch. Gallybob Gold Standard JW – Presented a balanced outline, nothing is exaggerated about this boy, soft gentle expression, good head and length to neck, shoulders a little heavy at the moment, good ribs, firm quarters, moved well in profile, front movement ok, let himself down on rear movement, he was moving close behind and would not put the drive in I know he has. In good coat and condition.**Res.CC.**

2nd Lambs Casafelice Askanian – Impressive outline on this boy, liked his overall balance, lovely head, eye and expression, strong firm body, very well constructed throughout, good coat and color, just felt he did not put his all in when on the move today.

3rd Wards Caispern Nicolaus Silver Cum Copperwhite

Junior Bitch (4) 1 absentee

1st Baynes Corranroo Cruz - What a smart young lady this is, much to like about her, good head, sweet expression, good length of neck, firm back line, straight front, neat feet, lovely colour and in good condition, lovely profile movement, sound fore and aft.

2nd Harts Gilliegrae Cineal Niamh, A taller bitch than my winner, sweet head and expression, good front, good length to neck, shoulders a little upright, good ribs, good colour, moved soundly.

3rd Lambs Casafelice St. Croix.

Post Grad Bitch 12 (3 absentees)

Lovely class, some really nice bitches I liked on the stack let themselves badly on the move.

1st Davies Zymore Christmas Rose – One I have done well before and have not changed my mind, lovely headed bitch with a melting expression, tidy front, well angulated front and rear, good length to neck, clean shoulders, well sprung ribs, good bend to stifle, short rear pasterns, in lovely coat and condition, sound on the move both coming and going away. **Res.CC**

2nd Tubbys Taniswood Anything Goes – Striking young lady in profile, well balanced all through, lovely head, eye and expression, straight front, slightly lumpy over the shoulders, good ribs, good bend of stifle, in beautiful condition, and very sound on the move, nice girl.

3rd Barcrofts Ballakinnish Muse.

Limit Bitch 5 (2 absentees)

1st Pilmers Corranroo Celtic Connection With Anisbrig – Another young lady I have done well for in the past and I have not changed my high opinion of her, the most delightful head, eye and expression, good length of neck to clean well placed shoulders, good spring to ribs, well bent stifles, in good coat and condition, lovely colour, feet could be tighter, did enough on the move to win this class, but could not get her act together on the move in the challenge.

2nd Wards Ballakinnish Mischief Making Copperwhite – Only a youngster, but, I really do like this bitch very much. Beautiful head, eye and expression, good length to neck, clean over the shoulders, good spring to ribs, firm loin, strong well angulated quarters, lovely colour, and coat coming along nicely, moved well in profile, but just a little close behind today. One for the future.

3rd Peacocks Spiralwood Sweet Mulberry.

Open Bitch 4.

Lovely class of quality bitches, the first 3 can and will change places many times.

1st Barcrofts Sh.Ch/Ir.Sh.Ch. Ballakinnish Mistinguette – Upstanding, but, outstanding bitch of great quality throughout, classic head in profile, dark eye, sweet expression, correct straight front, lovely shoulders, good depth to ribs which are well sprung, firm through the loin, strong powerful quarters which she used to great advantage on the move, this bitch just powers around the ring with such a smooth ground covering gait it is a joy to watch. She was in good coat and condition, so sound fore and aft. It was with great pleasure that I awarded this most beautiful example of our breed the **CC and Best of Breed**.

2nd Sherratts Charnborough Glamour Girl – Smaller package than the winner, such a sweet expression on this young lady, good head, good eye shape, enough length to neck, clean over the shoulders. Ribs well sprung, lovely colour, good angulation front and rear, firm in body, just did not put enough effort into her movement on the day.
